



Certificate of Conformity

EU Directive 2002/95/EC (ROHS),
2011/65/EU (ROHS II) and 2015/863/EU (ROHS III)

We hereby confirm that articles supplied by Ståldepån AB are in general not conflicting with the above-mentioned European Directives.

This means that the articles are not containing any of the below mentioned chemicals to such an extent that they are unusable for ROHS critical end products.

- Lead (Pb) and its compounds
- Mercury (Hg) and its compounds
- Cadmium (Cd) and its compounds
- Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB)
- Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE, e.g. PentaBDE and OctaBDE)
- Chromium (Cr (VI)) and its compounds
- Bis(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP)
- Butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP)
- Dibutyl phthalate (DBP)
- Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP)

The scope of this Certificate of Conformity is all alloys, except for the aluminum alloys 2007, 2011 and 6262. Might you however need specific articles of alloy 2011 and 6262 in compliance with the mentioned EU Directives, such articles can be provided on demand, too.

Aluminium alloys are covered by the exceptions in Annex 3 – point 6.b in the ROHS regulations.
